- University policy prohibits staff from entering into venue contracts and collecting registration money. Committees can collect RSVPs and payments via Eventbrite or your preferred platform.
- The Committee is encouraged to promote the event through social media outlets. Wharton AR Liaisons may also assist in marketing the Pre-Reunion event.
- Event information will be posted to Class Pages on the Reunion website. Wharton requests a two-week lead time before the event to add information and registration links.
- Committees are asked to share event RSVP lists and any photos of the event with their Alumni Class Liaison.
